DECLARATION OF TANYA NOZAWA IN SUPPORT OF PETITION FOR TEMPORARY RESTRAINING **ORDER**

I, TANYA NOZAWA, make the following declaration:

- 1. I have knowledge of the facts stated herein and am competent to testify.
- 2. I am a member of the organization Save the Davis-Meeker Garry Oak (SDMGO). On May 23, 2024, I was at the Davis Meeker Garry Oak next to the Olympia Airport in Tumwater. This tree is 400 years old and is on the historic register. I was tying a yellow ribbon around it because the Mayor of Tumwater is trying to have the tree removed, despite the incredible community opposition to her proposal and opposition from arborists as well who believe that she is making this decision based on a flawed risk assessment of the tree.
- 3. Regarding the flawed risk assessment, I would like to bring the court's attention the three arborists' opinions on this website: https://www.davis-meeker-oak.org/arborist-s-<u>viewpoint</u>. They have pointed out that the tree is structurally sound, in contrast to the city's

arborist. At least one of them pointed out that city's arborist provided a low-budget assessment, which is wholly inappropriate given the historical importance of this tree.

- 4. While I was at the tree on May 23rd, I noticed that the city had just put up signs stating that the tree was dangerous. They had not been there when I drove past earlier.
- 5. I'm on the Tumwater Tree Board. I have been on it for seven years. Our role is to protect trees and approve heritage trees. We are working on approving street trees. We advise the city council on urban forestry issues or any other tree matter.
- 6. At the May 21, 2024, Tumwater City Council meeting, the city administrator under the mayor told the council that the mayor had sent out a request for bids in February 2024 for removal of the Meeker oak. I was approached on May 23, 2024, by a person who stated that they had inside information from someone who works with the City of Tumwater. They said that the mayor has accepted a bid to remove the tree and that the mayor had directed that this work be done during the Memorial Day Weekend when everyone was out of town. Upon hearing this, I immediately contacted my colleagues in SDMGO and relayed the information to them.
- 7. I have seen birds in the oak tree that appear to me to be nesting. They are not pigeons.
- 8. I was told that the reason the mayor is trying to push through the removal of the tree so quickly (and in violation of so many rules) is that she wants to expand the Olympia Airport. SDMGO has a website that states this is the reason. SDMGO also has a Facebook group. On May 23, 2023, a woman named Joy Johnston commented on the Facebook group that the webpage should not state that the mayor is removing the tree to expand the airport because this constitutes making up information. A member of SDMGO researched Joy Johnson's background and discovered that Ms. Johnston's firm, Mojostrategies.com, apparently is being paid by the

Tumwater mayor's office or the City of Tumwater to provide "Public Sector Communications and Public Relations." Attached hereto as Exhibit A is a true and correct redacted copy of the Facebook page with Ms. Johnston's comment at the bottom of page 1 and with the subsequent comment about Ms. Johnston's firm apparently being the PR firm for the mayor's office, on page
