the prairies. It would be one major loss in the entire story of the prairies. Recognition of our heritage is incredibly important. It is part of what we have fought for and lost so much of already. It would be an incredible disappointment for me knowing that people do not care about that aspect of our heritage and our way of life.

5. When you go to Fort Lewis, there is a remnant of the oak savannahs. The artillery causes fires, and those fires preserve the savannah. Elsewhere, the burning stopped 100 years ago. The Tribe has some oak savannah in Toledo--a small portion that we are protecting. The oak savannas are in a protected status.

I declare under the penalty of perjury of the laws of the State of Washington that the foregoing is true and correct to the best of my knowledge.
