- 4. I later took another video of the kestrel perched across the street on the top of a Douglas fir tree. I gave the footage to Ronda Larson Kramer, who put my videos of the kestrels up on our website here: <a href="https://www.davis-meeker-oak.org/media-releases">https://www.davis-meeker-oak.org/media-releases</a>.
- 5. I first learned to identify birds in Washington state from my father when I was a child. I also use the Merlin Bird ID sound recording app to identify birds by sound. As a result, I am able to identify kestrels from not only their shape, coloring and flight pattern, but also from their calls. The life history of kestrels is such that they do not use nest cavities unless they are nesting.
